## PARTICIPATION IN NETWORKS & RESEARCH LINES

### FOOTBALL MIGRATION NETWORK (hosted at ICS-UL)

The network (foomi-net) was founded at the University of Hannover (Germany) in January 2009. The objectives of the foomi-net are to provide a forum to researchers who work on the subject, to disseminate information and results of research on Football and Migration, to organize events, and to support fund raising activities for future research projects at international scale.

## PERMOB, ICS-UL

In the framework of the Research Lines of the Laboratório Associado at ICS-UL, the DIASBOLA project is integrated in the line PERMOB (codename PERMOB – “person and mobility”) which focuses on human mobility and the processes of identity construction and cultural construction associated with contemporary transnational trends (with special reference to Lusophone regions). Our main research category is the concept of the “person” seen from an interdisciplinary perspective. We aim to study its relations to the main axes of social differentiation (gender, class and ethnicity) with special reference to human mobility in terms of contemporary trends of international hegemony.
